Online CPD Webinar Series 2022

The new UKCS Steering Committee has embarked on an ambitious programme of webinars for this Autumn. Planned topics include: Artificial Sphincter, Recurrent UTI, Urodynamics (contributing to re-accreditation), OAB, Pessary Certification, Neuromodulation Advances, OASIS and Bladder 101 / PN Voiding dysfunction- Pelvic floor.
