UKCS Code of Conduct

All UKCS members are required to sign up to this Code of Conduct, which aims to ensure our members work to the UKCS's objectives & standards.

UKCS members should not place themselves under any financial or other obligation to outside individuals or organisations, or engage in promotional activities, that might influence them in the performance of their healthcare practice.

In all activities, including communications with other UKCS members and non-members, patients and the media (including Social media);

UKCS members should not:

- 1. be inflammatory, defamatory of any person or organisation, hateful or obscene.
- 2. promote any discrimination, based on age, gender, race, religion, nationality or sexual orientation.
- 3. infringe any copyright or trademark.
- 4. be threatening or abusive, or likely to embarrass, upset or alarm others.
- 6. Impersonate any person, or to misrepresent your identity or affiliation with any person or organisation.
- 7. Say or post anything that they know to be dishonest, untrue, or misleading. If members have a vested interest in something they are discussing, they should point it out.

Policy violations will be subject to action, at the discretion of the Lead Committee and Trustees.
